

Dear Alliance families,

Reach Counseling will present a protective behaviors program to Alliance students in grades 1, 3 and 4. Students will learn to say “no” to confusing or uncomfortable touches, learn rules for keeping their bodies safe and learn that they are never at fault in cases of abuse. Students will also be encouraged to identify adults who they can trust when they need help or protection. The 3rd and 4th grade programs include information on sexual abuse. The information will be presented by a Reach Counselor who specializes in educating children about staying safe.

Parents are invited and encouraged to share in their child’s experience, either through attending the program or by discussing the topic at home. If you would like to attend the program, please see the schedule below:
