or brush. Your painted frame will be fused in our kiln after class and available for pick-up up at a later date. Please arrive before 6:30pm so you will have enough time to finish your project. All ages welcome.

Come with the whole family and celebrate Earth Day by using recycled glass bottles to create a beautiful one of a kind work of GLASS art. Students will learn how to cut a glass bottle into pieces to be repurposed. Special considerations when using recycled glass will be discussed and you will go home with a lot more knowledge about recycled glass and how you can make it into an art masterpiece. Introduction to Glass Beadmaking – Adult Class

Saturday, April 4, 10:00 am-1:00 pm
Class Fee \$90

Basic bead making techniques will be covered in this three hour introductory class. Learn about safe and proper handling of equipment, tools, and materials. You will learn how to pull stringers, layer color, and apply surface decoration. By the end of the class, you will have created several of your own glass beads!



Make a Drinking Glass from Bottles – Adult Class

Bring three beer or wine bottles to the museum and make them into drinking glasses. You will learn the process of bottle cutting using a scoring tool, a candle and a bucket of ice water. How simple is that? We will discuss several ways to create drinking glasses from recycled bottles. Cheese and wine will be provided so you can try your freshly made glasses right away! Class Fee \$90

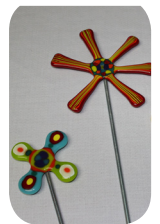

Open Studio is available to anyone who has taken an Introduction to Fusing and Slumping or Introduction to Flameworking class. (If you have glass experience and have not taken a class at BMMOG, please bring in or email examples of your work to be eligible to use our classroom tools or torches). •• ages 16 and up •• You must register for Open Studio.

Guidelines:

An instructor is on-site and available for questions and safety. However there is no class instruction. Students will work independently. They may use our safety glasses and basic tools and may purchase glass rods from our supply.

We are a Bullseye Glass studio, so we ask that you please only use Bullseye glass (unless you are doing borosilicate flameworking). Payments for projects will be made on-site.
