EDUCATOR OPEN FORUM

This session is an open forum where educators from around the district will be available to answer your questions, offer advice, and discuss strategies for whatever your concerns may be. (Literacy help, math help, homework help, etc...)

EXECUTIVE FUNCTION - NO SUIT, NO TIE ... JUST GOOD THINKING!

Executive Function refers to the set of mental skills we all use to "get things done." It's the term used to describe the way our brains help us attend, plan, organize, problem solve, remember, and monitor our own behavior. Student issues and breakdowns are often caused when students have not yet developed effective Executive Function. This session will give a brief overview of how our brains work; what happens when these thinking skills are not working so well; and strategies to overcome the issues, concerns, and challenges related to (not-so) good thinking. This session is excellent, but not exclusively, for parents of children with ADHD, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Learning Disabilities, Mood Disorder, and Brain Injury.
